



However, we are concerned that unless properly considered, the legitimate commercial relationships between content rights holders and broadband network customers might be subject to interference as a result of broadband network management techniques. Therefore, we recommend that in connection with defining nondiscrimination obligations under the BTOP, NTIA and RUS should not permit any grantee to engage in any unilateral broadband network management technique that interferes with content transmitted lawfully by a content rights holder to a broadband network customer.
