BOARD RESOLUTION 17

Report to Congress February 12, 2013

WHEREAS, Congress enacted the Middle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act of 2012 (Act), which

mandates the creation of a nationwide interoperable wireless broadband network that will enable law

enforcement, firefighters, emergency medical service professionals, and other public safety officials to

more effectively communicate and perform their missions;

WHEREAS, the Act creates the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet), an independent authority

within the Department of Commerce's National Telecommunications and Information Administration,

charged to take "all actions necessary" to build, deploy, and operate the network, in consultation with

state, tribal, federal, and local entities;

WHEREAS, the Act requires FirstNet to submit an annual report covering the preceding fiscal year to the

appropriate committees of Congress;

WHEREAS, the Act requires that the annual report include: "(1) a comprehensive and detailed report of

the operations, activities, financial condition, and accomplishments of the First Responder Network

Authority under this section; and (2) such recommendations or proposals for legislative or administrative

action as the First Responder Network Authority deems appropriate."

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the FirstNet Board adopts its First Report to Congress and

directs Chairman Ginn to deliver the report to the appropriate committees of Congress.
