## Contract Execution: N/A

Governance: We had two governance group meetings this quarter. One in person meeting in May and a conference call meeting in April to go over the FirstNet data collection information and obtain guidance on how to proceed.

Education and Outreach: Nebraska provided a FirstNet fact sheet to the Nebraska Hospital association who distributed the factsheet electronically via 884 newsletter subscribers and 480 twitter recipients. We also held a conference call to talk about FirstNet with 10 Volunteer organizations that may be involved in our response and recovery efforts regarding a catestrophic event. We sent 31 letters to Rural Public Power Districts informing them of FirstNet and the upcoming survey requests. Emailed 5 counties that hadn't identified a FirstNet representative and asked them to provide a representative at this time. We have a distribution list of 232 people on our ListSrv account and during this quarter we sent out 6 messages with links to FirstNet information, brochures, videos, etc for a total of 1,992 recipients.

Phase 2-Uswers and Their Operational Areas - We began to develop an on-line survey for the information FirstNet is requesting. This is Stage one activity.
