Comment: CAS Cable currently provides full, robust broadband service in its service areas, including Millwood, Evans, Cottageville, Mt Alto, Ravenswood and Ripley in Jackson County. In addition, CAS Cable advertises service of speeds above 3 Mbps throughout the Jackson County service area. Also, we pass over 50% of households, and have actual subscribership of over 40% of households in the service area. See attached maps, exhibits and responses. Therefore, the service areas identified in this response are NOT "underserved."

Comment: This response conclusively demonstrates that Suddenlink and its competitors already offer robust broadband service within the mapped area of the applicant's proposed funded service area and that this mapped area is neither unserved nor underserved.
