The service is offered at every customer location in our serving area, which in this case is a small part of the City of Davenport. Our serving area for this application would be the portion north of Interstate 80. The portion South of Interstate 80 is served by another telecom provider. Subscribership is 100% of locations within our regulated telephone exchange area
