Comment: Based on the requirements for broadband stimulus funding outlined in the Federal Notice of Funds Availability, released jointly by the U.S. Department of Agriculture and the U.S. Department of Commerce on July 9, 2009 in the Federal Register, the application filed by the University of Louisville Research Foundation, proposing to serve portions of Jefferson County, Indiana, must be underserved by broadband. In the proposed service area containing the city of Louisville, Kentucky, greater than 50 percent of households have access to facilities- based, terrestrial broadband service, households in the proposed service area have access to broadband speeds of 20 Mbps downstream provided by Insight Communications, and greater than 40 percent of households in the proposed service area have subscribed to broadband provided by Insight Communications and other broadband service providers. Due to the fact that this proposed service area is not, in fact, neither unserved nor underserved by broadband, it is not eligible for funding under the July 9, 2009 NOFA.
