Dear Ms. Keeney:

The FCC Public Notice DA 98-842, released May 4, 1998 contained a preliminary view that addressed agenda item 1.12. This preliminary view was revised by the RCS and approved by the IRAC. The following is our revision of the preliminary view for agenda item 1.12:

**WRC-00 Agenda Item 1.12:** *to consider the progress of studies on sharing between feeder links of non-GSO MSS networks and GSO FSS networks in the bands 19.3-19.7 GHz and 29.1-29.5 GHz, taking into account Resolution 121 (Rev. WRC-97);*

**ISSUE:** ~~WRC-99 Agenda Item 1.12: Resolution 121.~~ Sharing Between NGSO MSS Feederlinks and GSO FSS Networks in the Bands 19.3-19.7 GHz and 29.1-29.5 GHz (~~WAC/015(27.04.98)~~)

**BACKGROUND:** Resolution 121 requests that the ITU-R conduct a study of sharing possibilities between GSO FSS and NGSO MSS feederlinks in the bands 19.3-19.7 GHz and 29.1-29.5 GHz.

**PRELIMINARY VIEW:** Resolution 121 is no longer necessary because the issue of GSO/NGSO sharing in the feederlink bands is being resolved/addressed in the ITU-R Working Party 4A. A deletion of the reference to Resolution 121 in S5.541A would follow.
