Three FTE (1.20) joined the Alabama FirstNet Program Initiative and work as the Grant Manager identified in the budget as 1.0 FTE, Legal Counsel identified in the budget as .10 FTE and Communications Manager identified in the budget as .10 FTE. There was one contract terminated for Program Director, Terrance Carson and one ontract executed for Meghan Echols, as a replacement. Further collaboration was done with various information technology departments that resulted in the completion of outreach materials, social media and website.
