SPECIAL AWARD CONDITIONS Award Number EDU.01 Amendment Number Four (4)

- 1. EDUCAUSE shall take all actions necessary to complete a competitive solicitation for DN propagation services, award a subcontract, obtain approval from the Grants Officer of such subcontract, and implement the technical transition from the current subcontractor to any successor subcontractor before August 13, 2003.
- 2. EDUCAUSE shall submit to the Federal Program Officer its competitive solicitation for DNS propagation services no later than April 30, 2003. Written approval will be provided to EDUCAUSE by the Grants Officer.
- 3. Any subcontract for DNS propagation services is subject to the terms of Special Award Conditions 6 and 7.
- 4. Any competitive solicitation for DNS propagation services shall provide for either an application programming interface (API) to update data in the .edu zone file maintained by the subcontractor or an API to update the .edu zone file of the root DNS server maintained by the subcontractor.
