Narrative description for each activity reported in Question 11 for this quarter; and any additional project Three Arizona Public Safety Broadband Network (AZPSBN) governance meetings were held during the quarter to update participants on FirstNet efforts and discuss the process to formalize an SIEC through a Governor's Executive Order. There were 8 stakeholder events convened during the quarter. 125 public safety stakeholders were given information on FirstNet during the events.

A multi-discipline state leadership team was sent to Portland, Oregon to attend to National Governance models and allowed the state team to network with other states to identify best practices that can be implemented in Arizona.

Arizona also had representation at the Public Safety Communications Research (PSCR) conference in San Diego. The conference was informative and provided valuable information on FirstNet.

Work began on the planning for integration of the PSAPs and LMR systems with FirstNet. A project scope and timeline was developed as well as identification of stakeholders in the PSAP communities. The AZ Department of Public Safety continues to test the FirstNet/LMR integration and is documenting successes and challenges.
