Met with Kauai Police Department, Fire, and American Medical Response (EMS) for the 30-day in-filed coverage testing. This was done by providing Android units on the FirstNet network to individual police, fire and EMS personnel and having them drive around to sample coverage in various locations as part of their regular patrols and responses. As a result of the testings, the data has been mapped. We continue to work with AT&T to overlay the in field testing with the coverage studies. With the in-state travel ban lifted, coordination will be made to meet with the public safety personnel to plot out where the gaps are and how they may be addressed by the additional towers that AT&T is required to build as part of the Hawaii opting into the FirstNet network. If there are specific areas that need more immediate attention, we can try to come up with an interim solution such as a COW. We are also working with Maui County to begin their in-field testing.

Legislation submitted last quarter is on hold with the Legislation which postponed session due to the COVID-19 response. The Legislature is in special session however the bill was not moved forward for a hearing during this special session. We'll have to wait on the biennium legislative guidance to be issues to determine if the proposed legislation will need to be resubmitted or if we must resubmit a new bill.
