During the quarter, activities focused on SLIGP 2.0 grant setup, including amending contracts for SLIGP 2.0. Planning was conducted in preparation for a Massachusetts FirstNet Advisory Board meeting scheduled for April. Meetings were conducted with AT&T and FirstNet to discuss several topics related to the rollout of the NPSBN in Massachusetts and the improvement of coverage.
