Narrative description for each activity reported in Question 11 for this quarter; any challenges or obstacles encountered and mitigation strategies you have employed; planned major activities for the next quarter; and any additional project During the quarter, activities focused on establishing a statewide contract for the purchasing of public safety wireless broadband data services. A request for quotation (RFQ) was drafted and published on the Commonwealth's procurement system, COMMBUYS. Bids from wireless providers are expected in July. Bidders meeting public safety wireless standards will be qualified to sell priority based services on a new subcategory of the existing statewide contract for communications services.

The Massachusetts FirstNet Advisory Board (MFAB) was convened in April to discuss developments with the national public safety broadband network. AT&T/FirstNet were invited to present to the MFAB. Meetings were conducted with AT&T and FirstNet to discuss several topics related to the rollout of the NPSBN in Massachusetts and the improvement of coverage. Members of the PSBO continued to participate in periodic and repeating stakeholder meetings to answer questions about FirstNet in Massachusetts. Three members of the PSBO attended the Public Safety Communications Research Annual Meeting in San Diego and participated in FirstNet related presentations and events.

A newsletter update concerning FirstNet and wireless public safety broadband was drafted in June and is scheduled to be distributed to the PSBO distribution list in July. EOPSS agencies continued to work with AT&T to establish secure data connections to Commonwealth data sources.

Data Sharing Policies/Agreements Developed (11.7): Continued to work with AT&T to communicate security and access standards for connecting FirstNet users with criminal history data stores at the Department of Criminal Justice Information Services.

Further Identification of Potential Public Safety Users (11.8): Updated contact lists for communications distribution to public safety leaders throughout the Commonwealth. Discussed plans for determining eligible public safety users as part of ongoing statewide public safety wireless broadband services RFQ.
