The Office of Information Technology Executive Director of Client and Infrastructure Services provided Match for this grant for the quarter and he also assumed the role of SPOC when David Maxwell retired on October 31, 2020. Match is also provided by the Office of Information Technology Director of Radio Operations who oversees the state radio network (MSCommNet) as well as DAFS administrative staff processing payroll and invoices. Per the recent budget modification the Consultant attributed time towards Match as well. For 11.1, one governance team meeting occurred during the quarter on 10/27/20. For 11.2, no broadband conferences were held. For 11.3, one stakeholder event was held. It was a two-part "roadmapping" session, Part II was held on 10/1/2020. Most other special events planned during the quarter were cancelled or postponed to 2021 due to COVID-19. For 11.11, conversations with stakeholders continued regarding known or perceived gaps in proposed coverage. Additional activities during the quarter were: several emails and calls regarding the State of Maine budget modification for the SLIGP2 grant; a quarterly call with NTIA on December 32, 2020; and a project update at the quarterly E911 Advisory meeting on December 8, 2020. Also, a clarifying call was held to discuss drive testing, some including NTIA on December 7,2020. Several calls with FirstNet ME and project team occurred weekly throughout the quarter.
