Stakeholder Meetings - No Firstnet outreach meetings as the State has been awaiting the results of the Federal procurement and received first notice that the protest was resolved on March 28, 2017

Broadband Conferences - 2 Attendees participated in a FirstNet conference call special meeting on March 28, 2017

Staff Hires - We continue to use the part time services of a program manager, accountant, CIO, CFO, Project Sponsor, Project Management Specialist, and a Procurement Office.

Governance Meetings - Statewide Interoperability Executive Committee convened on three occassions to discuss public safety interoperability. The Program Manager updated the committee on the status of the federal program and ongoing proposal process.

Education and Outreach - We had 262 visits to our ND FirstNet websites resulting in 175 unique page views. ND FirstNet is finalizing a video-based certified training program for first responders that explains the value of utilizing FirstNet services. The State required the Contractor to make corrections and will deliver a final product to Public Safety organizations throughout the State in the next quarter.
