Narrative description for each activity reported in Question 11 for this quarter; any challenges or obstacles encountered and mitigation strategies you have employed; planned major activities for the next quarter; and any additional project milestones or [#5] The State of Oklahoma has entered into a contract with AT&T Mobility - NetMotion for the NetMotion Mobility, Diagnostic, and Mobile IQ tools to assist in the performance of the Coverage Gap Analysis Project. This contract was initially entered into in October 2019 but was placed in an incorrect line item with the State. This has been corrected and is now included on the Contractual Section of this report. [#9] SLIGP 2.0 Staff has reopened the review of Emergency Communications technologies currently in play within the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety and underlying agencies. Testing of the incorporation of the NPBN was performed and a meeting with the Authority, Partner, and Agency Executives is being scheduled for this quarter. [#11] The State of Oklahoma has foreset a majority of time on this project. A combination of the NetMotion tools listed above, the ESRI GIS Mapping program, and an assortment of free apps and programs are being used to provide the best possible Analysis to those public safety entities that have requested the review. In addition, the State of Oklahoma welcomed the POTUS to the City of Tulsa for a campaign rally in June 2020. This allowed the State to perform multiple tests of the network in regards to coverage, service reliability, and network performance during a high network traffic event. This information is being built into an After Action Report and will be reviewed in a joint session between the State, Authority, and Partner.

UPDATE: Added AT&T Mobility - NetMotion contract as a separate line item in the Contractual section of the budget. This contract allows OKPSBN to perform the Coverage Gap Analysis project using the programs Mobility, Diagnostic, and Mobile IQ. The current amount expended on this contract is \$11,306.05. Small Event Venues and Meeting Spaces do not provide actual "contracts" to rent facilities. Currently, we have expended \$14,722.81 in contracts for event venues. This is a CORRECTED amount from the previous quarter as we have pulled the NetMotion Contract amounts separate from our "small event venues and meet spaces" line item as it was coded in error since October 2019. We have reduced the allocated amount for a FirstNet Statewide Conference as the possibility for performing a large conference in January 2021 is dwindling due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
