Testing of the incorporation of the NPSBN is ongoing with the Executive Offices as they relate to emergency management during incidents. [#11] The State of Oklahoma has focused a majority of time on this project. A combination of NetMonion Tools and Software, the ESRI GIS Mapping program, and an assortment of free apps and programs are being used to provide the best possible Analysis to those public safety entities that have requested the review. Maps and data collected are compared to the appropriate IOC Coverage Map from the FirstNet State Plan Portal and additional meetings are held between the State and Partner to discuss any gaps in coverage that may require immediate attention. The rollout of the 5G initiative within the Partner has caused multiple challenges on this project.
