[#3] The State of Oklahoma hosted the Oklahoma City Area FirstNet Expo on November 6, 2019 in Oklahoma City, OK at the request of the FirstNet Authority. This Expo focused on the latest updates and capabilities of the FirstNet Offering and included demonstrations by the Authority, Partner, and SLIGP 2.0 Staff. (A letter from the FirstNet Authority is on file and attached to this report.) [#8] The State of Oklahoma is working with the Authority and Partner to establish the requirements for City/County Health Department employees to utilize FirstNet. Current attempts for any agency under this category have been denied. [#9] SLIGP 2.0 Staff continues to attend meetings and conferences with multiple disciplines to review the Emergency Communications technologies currently in play within specific agencies and provide recommendations/best practices for incorporating the Partner is still the most problematic when addressing this project. [#11] The State of Oklahoma has focused a majority of time on this project. Agencies that are in coverage areas completed by the Partner's buildout of the network have requested Coverage Gap Analysis from the State in order to address issues where coverage is limited or non-existent but listed as fully-capable by the Partner. Issues thus far have been the agencies utilizing outdated technologies that do not operate on Band 14.
