Narrative description for each activity reported in Question 11 for this quarter; any challenges or obstacles encountered and mitigation strategies you have employed; planned major activities for the next quarter; and any additional project milestones or [#3] The State of Oklahoma hosted the Tulsa Area FirstNet Expo on February 5, 2020 in Broken Arrow, OK at the request of the FirstNet Authority. This Expo focused on the latest updates and capabilities of the FirstNet Offering and included demonstrations by the Authority, and SLIGP 2.0 Staff. (A letter from the FirstNet Authority is on file and attached to this report.) [#7] The State of Oklahoma is creating planning documents to initiate Data Sharing between state public safety agencies and mutual aide providers at the county and local level. Preliminary discussions began during this quarter; however, the COVID-19 response has hindered progress. The SLIGP 2.0 staff has also assisted in the review of the Oklahoma Field Operations Guide (OKFOG) developed through the Oklahoma field Operations Guide (OKFOG) developed through the Oklahoma office of Homeland Security and is reviewing options to include the OKFOG in future Data Sharing projects. [#8] The State of Oklahoma is working with the Authority and Partner to review the requirements for Information Technology entities that are not considered CyberSecurity employees to utilize FirstNet. Current attempts for any agency under this category have been returned on multiple occassions as providing CyberSecurity functions seems to be their main need for approval. [#9] SLIGP 2.0 Staff continues to attend meetings and conferences with multiple disciplines to review the Emergency Communications technologies currently in play within specific agencies and provide recommendations/best practices for incorporating the NPSBN - many of these events have been halted due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
