During the period of time captured in this quarter, July through September 2018, the following personnel contributed time: the Deputy SPOC, the Policy Specialist and the Administrative Officer as well as the SPOC and the GIS Manager. We started our stakeholder meetings with the task forces in Pennsylvania during the month of August. The PA-FirstNet team along with FirstNet and AT&T participated in two meetings in August as well as three meetings in September. During some of the meetings there are valuable interaction occurring; however, during others we have been told that the stakeholders have heard the message multiple times due to AT&T's saturation of marketing to the public safety community. We will continue to engage the community in an effort to discuss any questions and concerns that they may have moving forward as well as to create a governance structure to assist in large scale responses where spectrum resources may be strained.
