13b. Narrative description any challenges, updates, or changes related to contracts and/or subrecipients.

We started our stakeholder meetings with the task forces in Pennsylvania during the third quarter of 2018 continuing into the fourth quarter and likely into 2019. The PA-FirstNet team along with FirstNet and AT&T participated in four meetings in October as well as an online meeting in December. An additional meeting was scheduled for November; however, that meeting had to be postponed due to inclement weather and poor travelling conditions but has been rescheduled for January. During many of the meetings, valuable interaction between our team, the FirstNet/AT&T team and the stakeholders are occurring; however, during others we have been told that the stakeholders have heard the meetings due to AT&T's saturation of marketing to the public safety community. We will continue to engage the community in an effort to discuss any questions and concerns that they may have moving forward as well as to create a governance structure to assist in large scale responses where spectrum resources may be strained. A re-write of the SCIP is planned for 2019 to include feedback and input from our stakeholders.
