Continued to work with SAIC throughout the quarter to develop content for FirstNet in Utah website. Held bi-weekly meetings with SAIC to go over progress and discuss next steps for website content. This work culminated in a standalone FirstNet in Utah website hosted separate from the UCA website. We worked with Third Sun to add link from UCA website front page to FirstNet in Utah website. The new FirstNet in Utah website went live Dec 11th. Sent emails out to approximately 450 agencies and individuals with link to FirstNet in Utah website encouraging them to visit the site, learn more about FirstNet and AT&T and contact SPOC with any questions. Website can be viewed by going to www.uca911.org and clicking on the FirstNet button at the top of the front page. Began Work with SAIC to develop a white paper outlining costs to opt-in states for FirstNet Services. FirstNet updates were given to the UCA Executive Director for dissemination to the UCA board. No Broadband Advisory Meetings were held during the quarter. Participated in several NPSBN peer networking calls that were facilitated by the NGA. Met with Wasatch County to discuss questions they had after Governor Herbert opted-in. Subsequent meeting will be scheduled with Wasatch County, SPOC and AT&T after New Year.
