The commission received a project update from the FirstNet Region 1 Lead and AT&T representatives. While the state's opt-in decision has been made, the commission would like to meet as-needed to continue to serve an advocacy and planning role for the public safety community and serve an administrative role in receiving formal updates from FirstNet on the development of the network in Vermont. We concluded our series of regional information meetings on FirstNet with public safety personnel. In April, we held meetings in the Northwest and East regions. The purpose of the meetings was to facilitate discussion on the FirstNet build-out in Vermont. Meetings were held in coordination with FirstNet Region 1 Lead Michael Varney. We had 42 public safety personnel attend the two meetings, representing 28 separate organizations. Upon the request of the organizers of the Twin State Regional Fire School and the Vermont Constable's Association, we made presentations about FirstNet at two separate meetings. In total, we presented information to 120 people. In the third quarter, we plan to release an RFP for planning activities detailed in our SLIGP 2.0 grant application. We will also facilitate a demonstration of broadband technology at the 2018 Vermont Emergency Preparedness Conference in September in Vermont in cooperation with AT&T and 12. Personnel 12a.
