Narrative description for each activity reported in Question 11 for this quarter; any challenges or obstacles encountered and mitigation strategies you have employed; planned major activities for the next quarter; and any additional project The Public Safety Broadband Network Commission met on October 17, 2018 and approved the selection of the Televate company to conduct FirstNet planning services. The action followed the release on August 2, 2018 of an RFP for services that was closed on August 31, 2018. Four bids were received and reviewed by a commission evaluation team. The work is funded through the SLIGP 2.0 grant. The contract has a not-to-exceed amount of \$108,000. Vermont first responders remain interested in the progress of the FirstNet buildout in Vermont. A newsletter updating the public safety community was distributed in October, 2018. The Department of Public Safety received two requests for updates on the network. The Pittsford Fire Academy requested a briefing on the FirstNet project for a training class for new dispatchers. There were seven traines in attendance at the October 11, 2018 meeting. The Governor's Advisory Council on Emergency Management requested a FirstNet project update for their December 12, 2018 meeting. Staff provided an update to 19 council members and attendees.
