As unemployment has continued to slide steadily upward in our area, reaching 12% as of June 2009, the demand for internet and computer access has also steadily increased. This has caused an increased volume of traffic in the Joblink center and the Public Library, which has a limited number of hard-wired computers. Additionally, at the Public Library the number of patrons that need the services of the Business and Career librarians has increased precipitating the need for additional workstations.

We would address the need by increasing the number of computers available and by implementing a wireless network infrastructure.

The Joblink Center system served over 25,000 individual job seekers last year throughout Guilford County. That number is expected to increase by up to 25% or more this year as layoffs continue and unemployment extensions begin to run out. Most of the unemployed or laid off workers need to access broadband service in conjunction with other activities that occur in JobLink Centers to maximize job search and/or retraining efforts. The Public Library will target areas of the city that are underserved by library resources. The library's public computer centers could potentially reach as many as 2340 customers a week. The demographic analysis for this project can be found in our supplemental documentation.

d. Qualifications of the applicant that demonstrate the ability to implement the project and achieve its intended results

The City of Greensboro Information Technology Department will work in conjunction with the Joblink and Library staff to implement this project. The City of Greensboro Information Technology Department has implemented projects city wide that touch over 2900 employees and most of the 248,000 citizens in the city. The IT staff is highly competent to handle this project.
