

Summary of State Broadband Data and Development Grant Program Eligible Applications

September 9, 2009

NTIA received applications representing all 50 states, 5 territories and the District of Columbia. Based on the budgets submitted by the applicants, NTIA estimates the two-year requests for broadband mapping funds (i.e. data collection, display and verification) will total approximately \$100 million. Fifty-two of the 56 states (or their designated entities) also submitted requests for broadband planning funds, typically about \$500,000 each over a 5-year period.
